This code of conduct is required of any parent or guardian who brings a child to a FSA Robotics program.

- Parents are valuable members of the team. Your support is needed during the challenge season.
- Your child's team is guided by its program's Core Values - please be familiar with these values to help your child and his/her team on their mission. Our parents are ambassadors of the FSA Robotics program.
- Please be courteous and arrive on time. Make sure your child is ready to participate fully.
- THIS IS NOT A DROP-OFF PROGRAM. A parent or guardian must be in attendance during the entire meeting time.
- Try to avoid absences - your team has a limited amount of team meetings during the challenge season and your child's participation is valuable to the team. That said, please keep sick children at home.
- Please take side conversations out to the hallway so the team is not distracted.
- "Stay present for your child's future." Honor our distraction-free environment by staying off your screens. If your child is being a distraction to the team or appears to be struggling or disengaging, we ask that you are proactive and assist the team in aiding your child before the coach asks for assistance.
- Children must have a parent/guardian present at special events or have arrangements made with the coach in advance. Please help your child follow the rules of his or her team.
- FIRST Robotics requires all of us to consider safety at all times. Report situations which you feel are potentially harmful to yourself or others. You can contact the team coaches, mentors, program leadership, or the school administration.

I understand the Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct and will follow these guidelines. I will ensure that any other adults accompanying my child to FSA Robotics activities will abide by the Code of Conduct.
